Biography:

After MBBS from KEMC in 1974, early career included Demonstrator of Pathology roles at KEMC and PGMI from 1975-1979, alongside being a Medical Officer at Pakistan Postal Dispensary. Joined AIMC as Assistant Professor Anatomy/Histopathology 1981-1983, then back to KEMC as Assistant Professor Pathology 1983-1989, rising to Associate Professor 1989-2000. Served as Professor of Pathology at PMC Faisalabad 2000-2002, Consultant Histopathologist at Chughtai Lab 2003-2008, and Professor of Pathology at LMDC 2003-2008. Currently Professor/HOD Pathology at Chughtai Institute, CEO of the Institute, and Founder of Chughtai Public Library. Also served as PAP President 2014-2016.
